

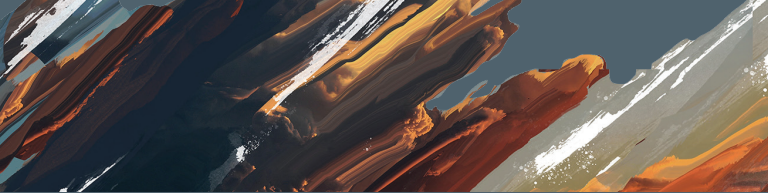


# THROUGH THE DEEP

## REFLECT | Week 5 | Exodus 14–15

1. In Exodus 14:1–4, God tells Moses that Pharaoh will pursue them and deliver them for God's glory, but God does not explain. How do you respond to God when there are many unknowns?
2. Why do you think the Israelites forgot the power and provision God displayed?
3. How did the Israelites feel when they saw the Egyptians? How would you describe their faith in God at that moment? Why do you think they struggled, even though they witnessed so many miracles?
4. When in life does God's faithfulness get pushed aside by the issues immediately before you?
5. Have difficult circumstances in your own life caused you to trust God more?



**RESPOND** | Write a set of song lyrics or a poem that expresses gratitude. It could be a song of praise about something for which you are grateful or lyrics about something for which you hope one day to be grateful. This need not be eloquent. Find a few words that express your current, or hoped for, gratitude and try to shape song lyrics around them.
